

DECISION ADB(D)22-2016

Adopting the Single Programming Document (SPD) 2017-2019

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SJU),

Having regard to:

- Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007, on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR)¹ as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008² and by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014³ ('SJU Regulation'), and in particular Article 5.1 (g) of the Annex to the SJU Regulation, "Statutes of the joint undertaking" ('SJU Statutes');
- Regulation (EU) No 1291/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing Horizon 2020 the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020) and repealing Decision No 1982/2006/EC, ("H2020");
- Regulation (EU) No 1290/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 laying down the rules for participation and dissemination in "Horizon 2020 the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020)" and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1906/2006, ("the Rules for Participation");
- Commission delegated regulation (EU) No 1271/2013 of 30 September 2013 on the framework financial regulation for the bodies referred to in Article 208 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council;
- Communication from the Commission C(2014) 9641 on the guidelines for programming document for decentralised agencies and the template for the Consolidated Annual Activity Report for decentralised agencies;
- SJU Administrative Board Decision ADB (D) 05-2015 adopting the SESAR 2020 Multi-Annual Work Programme, which covers the period 2016 - 2019 with an outlook to 2019-2021 and sets the content, objectives, budget and high-level description of the SESAR 2020 Research and Innovation Programme;
- SJU Administrative Board Decision ADB(D)08-2015 of 25 June 2015 adopting the SJU Financial Rule and in particular Article 32 thereof;



Whereas:

- In June 2016, the draft SPD was sent for consultation to the Members of the Administrative Board and to the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission;
- The iterative consultation process allowed the Board members and the European Commission relevant services to provide an opinion on the draft document;
- The comments received from the ADB Members during the consultation phase were analysed and integrated, as applicable, in the final draft provided to the Board on 25 November;
- The final draft was presented and discussed during the Administrative Board meeting ADB(M)038;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Single Programming Document (SPD) 2017-2019 is adopted.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
