

DECISION ADB(D)24-2016

Adopting the Methodology and validation process for In-kind Contributions (IKC) in the SJU (SESAR 2020 Programme only)

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SJU),

Having regard to:

- Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007, on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR)¹ as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008² and by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014³ ('SJU Regulation'), and in particular Article 12 (5) of the Annex to the SJU Regulation, "Statutes of the joint undertaking" ('SJU Statutes');
- The General Agreement between the EC and the SJU of 19 December 2014;
- The Membership Agreement SJU/LC/307-CTR, and in particular Article 10.03.02;

Whereas:

- Contributions in kind shall be subject to an evaluation of their value and their utility for carrying out the tasks of the Joint Undertaking;
- The Administrative Board shall be responsible for the assessment of contributions in kind;
- The methodology and validation process to assess in-kind contribution in the SJU (SESAR 2020 Programme only) was provided to the Board Members on XX November and (to be updated before the meeting: no comments were received/ was updated to take into account comments/...)
