AMENDMENT No.2 TO ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME (PLAN) 2015

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SJU),

Having regard to:

Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007 on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR) as modified by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008 and amended by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014 ('SJU Regulation'), in particular Articles 1.3, 1.4, 1.5 and 5.1(d) and (m) of the SJU Statutes annexed thereto ('SJU Statutes');

Whereas:

- Article 9(1) of the SJU Statutes states that in order to carry out the tasks defined in Article 1(5) of the SJU Regulation the SJU may conclude specific agreements with and award grants to its Members, in accordance with the applicable financial regulations;
- 2) Article 9(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1290/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 laying down the rules for participation and dissemination in "Horizon 2020 the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020)" and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1906/2006 ('Rules for Participation') sets out that, where appropriate and duly justified, work plans may provide for additional conditions according to specific policy requirements or to the nature and objectives of the action, including inter alia conditions regarding the number of participants, the type of participant and the place of establishment;
- 3) The SESAR 2020 Multiannual Work Programme adopted by the Board on 7 July 2015 (ADB(D)05-2015) provides, in conjunction with the respective Annual Work Programmes (Plans), the description of objectives to be pursued under SESAR 2020, the actions to be performed in this context as well as the terms and conditions according to which the SJU shall fund the actions performed; it equally contains provisions for two Calls for Proposals restricted to the SJU Members "SESAR 2020 IR-VLD Wave1" and "SESAR IR-VLD Wave 2" over the period to 2020;
- 4) The accession of new Members to the SJU, as well as the list of constituent entities of new SJU Members in the form of consortia has been decided by the Administrative Board by decision ADB(D)02-2016 adopted on 9 March 2016. Consequently, it is necessary to list in the Annual Work Programme 2015 the Members and their constituting entities, which are eligible to participate in the first restricted Call for Proposals "SESAR 2020 IR-VLD Wave1" of the SJU;
- 5) To align the list of Members set out in the SJU Annual Work Programme (Plan) 2015 as amended by ADB decision ADB(D)11-2015 to decision ADB(D)02-2016 and, where relevant, specify the constituent entities of SJU Members in the form of consortia, eligible as beneficiaries for the Call for Proposals "SESAR 2020 IR-VLD Wave1" for IR-VLD contributions to SESAR 2020 Programme, a limited update to the Annual Work Programme (Plan) 2015 Amendment No 1 has been drawn up and proposed as Amendment No 2;

- 6) The deadline of the Call for Proposals restricted to the SJU Members "SESAR 2020 IR-VLD Wave1" (call identifier H2020-SESAR-2015-2) has been extended to 20 April 2016 as specified on the H2020 Participant Portal on 7 March 2016;
- 7) In accordance with Articles 9 and 11 of the Administrative Board Rules of Procedure, a Written Procedure for the adoption of the current decision was launched on 9 March 2016 and concluded on 8 April with positive results.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Sole Article

The Administrative Board approves Amendment No 2 to the Annual Work Programme (Plan) 2015, as annexed to this decision.

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
