Adoption of the SJU Anti-Fraud Strategy

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SJU),

Having regard to:

- Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007 on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR) as modified by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008 and amended by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014;
- Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee, the Committee of the Regions and the Court of Auditors on the Commission anti-fraud strategy, COM(2011) 376;
- Communication to the Commission: Commission internal action plan for the implementation of the Commission anti-fraud strategy, SEC(2011) 787.
- Article 38 of the SJU Financial Rules adopted by the Administrative Board on 25 June 2015, which establishes that without prejudice to the responsibilities of the authorising officer as regards prevention and detection of fraud and irregularities, the SJU shall participate in fraud prevention activities of the European Anti-fraud Office.

Whereas:

 In accordance with Article 9 of the SJU Administrative Board's Rules of Procedure, the Written Procedure launched on 4 March 2016 for the adoption of the SJU Anti-Fraud Strategy was concluded with a positive result on 18 March 2016;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Board adopts the SJU Anti-Fraud Strategy annexed to the present decision.

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
