

DECISION

ADB(D)11-2019

Approving the Revised SESAR JU Organisation Chart

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SESAR JU),

Having regard to:

- Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007 on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR) as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008¹ and by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014 ('SJU Regulation') and more specifically Article 2a, and Articles 5.1 (f), 7.1, 7.5(a) and (c) of the Annex to the SJU Regulation, "Statutes of the joint undertaking" ('SJU Statutes'),
- The Administrative Board decision ADB(D)18-2014 of 11 December 2014 adopting the revised organisational chart proposed by the Executive Director,

Whereas:

- The need for the SESAR JU to continue to ensure its efficiency and effectiveness through adequate organisation principles in the areas of Finance, Planning and Reporting implies to create the new position of "Chief Financial Officer" that will report directly to the SESAR JU Executive Director.
- 2. The staff resources defined in the Multiannual Staff Policy Plan, Annex III to the SJU Single Programming Document 2019-2021, second amended version approved on 24.04.2019, allows the allocation of this position at grade AD12.
- 3. In accordance with Article 9 of the SJU Administrative Board's Rules of Procedure, a Written Procedure for the approval of the current decision was launched on 23 May 2019 and concluded on 6 June 2019 with positive results.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The revised SESAR JU Organisation Chart attached to this Decision, and including the position of "Chief Financial Officer" reporting directly to the SESAR JU Executive Director, is approved.



Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
