

## DECISION

ADB(D)07-2020

### adopting the second amended version of the SESAR JU Single Programming Document (SPD) 2020-2022

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SESAR JU),

#### Having regard to:

- Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007, on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR) <sup>(1)</sup>, as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008 <sup>(2)</sup> and by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014 ('SESAR JU Regulation') <sup>(3)</sup>, and the SESAR JU Statutes annexed thereto ('SESAR JU Statutes'),
- Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 <sup>(4)</sup>, and in particular Articles 6, 12, 18, 53, 70 and 110 thereof,
- Regulation (EU) No 1291/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing Horizon 2020 - the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020) and repealing Decision No 1982/2006/EC ('H2020 Regulation') <sup>(5)</sup>, and in particular Articles 23 and 25 thereof,
- Regulation (EU) No 1290/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 laying down the rules for participation and dissemination in 'Horizon 2020 - the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020)' and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1906/2006 ('the Rules for Participation') <sup>(6)</sup>, and in particular Article 11 thereof,
- Communication from the Commission C(2014) 9641 final on the guidelines for programming document for decentralised agencies and the template for the Consolidated Annual Activity Report for decentralised agencies,
- The SESAR JU Financial Rules adopted by the Administrative Board on 9 October 2019 (ref. ADB(D)-21-2019), and in particular Articles 25, 31, and 33 thereof,
- The SESAR JU Membership Agreement with reference SJU/LC/307-CTR, which sets forth the terms and conditions according to which the SESAR Public-Private Partnership is set up as defined under the SESAR JU Regulation and governs the contributions to the SESAR JU Public-Private Partnership, in particular Article 10.2.3 thereof,

**Whereas:**

- (1) By decision ADB(D)24-2019 of 17 December 2019, the SESAR JU Administrative Board adopted the SESAR JU Single Programming Document 2020-2022 ('SPD 2020-2022'). It was subsequently amended by the decision of the SESAR JU Administrative Board ADB(D)03-2020 of 1 April 2020.
- (2) At its 49<sup>th</sup> meeting on 7 May 2020, the SESAR JU Administrative Board has considered the COVID-19 crisis and its immediate impact on the economy of the aviation sector in general and on the SESAR JU Members.
- (3) The COVID-19 crisis will have a direct impact on the work programme of the SESAR JU for the year 2020, with in particular the cancellation of international events and the expected limitation of the number of missions;
- (4) To mitigate the adverse effects of the COVID-19 crisis, and taking into account the cancellation of some activities of its work programme for the year 2020, the SESAR JU has considered the following budgetary measures:
  - increase of the project pre-financing rates and postponement of the annual cash contribution payments by the Members other than the Union, aiming to support the cash-flow of the SESAR JU Members other than the European Union,
  - reduce its staff, infrastructure and operating expenditure,
  - agree on exceptionally reducing the instalment of cash contribution due by each Member other than the Union by 1 July 2020 under Article 10.2.3 of the Membership Agreement subject to an exchange of letter between the SESAR JU and its Members other than the Union.

These measures were presented to the SESAR JU Administrative Board and in principle agreed upon at its 49<sup>th</sup> meeting of 7 May 2020. To take effect, the measures should be included into the second amended version of the SPD 2020-2022 and budgetary adjustments laid out in detail in Annex II to this decision.

- (5) Considering the amount available for project funding under the operational budget, the reserve list that has been constituted as an outcome of the ER4 call for proposals (with reference H2020-SESAR-2019-2), and the objective to optimise the use of available funds, the Administrative Board has decided at its 49<sup>th</sup> meeting of the 7 May 2020, that an additional budget of up to EUR 15,4 million would be made available for new projects under the ER4 call for proposals, thus allowing an increase in the number of awarded projects. Therefore, the point 2.6.1.4 should be inserted in Section III of the SPD 2020-2022 to list the necessary adjustments of the ER4 call for proposals.
- (6) The cancellation or replanning of a number of events where SESAR JU's participation was planned and of publications planned by the SESAR JU in 2020 requires an adjustment to the tables related to the planning of events and publications in Section III - sub-paragraph 2.5.1 to outline updated indicative planning of related activities.
- (7) The continued support and expertise from stakeholders from the domain of airports is important for the steering and management of related SESAR JU activities. Therefore, the list of planned procurement activities laid out under the Strategic Area of Operation 5 (SESAR Outreach) in Annex IX should be updated to include new procurement procedures related to the support contracts.

- (8) The SPD 2020-2022 comprises the 2020 Annual Work Programme (<sup>(7)</sup>), the 2020-2022 Multi-Annual Work Programme, the 2020 Budget and the 2020 Staff Establishment Plan, and serves as the amended financing decision for the activities to be performed by the SESAR JU in 2020.
- (9) In accordance with Article 9 of the Rules of Procedure of the Administrative Board, a written procedure for the adoption of the second amended SESAR JU SPD 2020-2022 was launched on 29 May 2020 and concluded on 3 July 2020 with a positive result,

**HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Article 1**

The SESAR JU SPD 2020-2022 adopted by ADB decision no. ADB(D)24-2019 of 17 December 2019, as amended on 1 April 2020, is replaced by the second amended SESAR JU SPD 2020-2022 annexed to this decision.

**Article 2**

Upon adoption, the second amended SESAR JU SPD 2020-2022 shall be made publicly available on the website of the SESAR JU.

This decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
