

**DECISION**  
ADB(D)04-2021

**Approving the Revised SESAR JU Organisation Chart**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE SESAR JOINT UNDERTAKING (SESAR JU),

Having regard to:

- Council Regulation (EC) No 219/2007 of 27 February 2007 on the establishment of a Joint Undertaking to develop the new generation of the European Air Traffic Management system (SESAR)<sup>1</sup> as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1361/2008 of 16 December 2008<sup>2</sup> and by Council Regulation (EU) No 721/2014 of 16 June 2014<sup>3</sup> ('SJU Regulation') and more specifically Articles 5.1(f) and 7.5(c) of the Annex to the SJU Regulation, "Statutes of the joint undertaking" ('SJU Statutes'),
- Administrative Board decision ADB(D)11-2019 of 6 June 2019 adopting the revised organisation chart proposed by the Executive Director,

Whereas:

1. The SESAR JU needs to continue to improve its effectiveness by adequately assigning staff to the right tasks within the organisation. The following changes to the organisation chart shall be made:
  - a. The position of "Chief ATM" should be removed, as it is no longer in place.
  - b. The position "Chief Development and Delivery" should be renamed to "Chief Programme" because it corresponds to the position responsible for the Programme management Unit (PMU).
  - c. The position of "Chief Strategy and External Affairs" should be renamed to "Chief External Affairs and Communication" to align it to the new tasks assigned to this position.
2. In accordance with Article 9 of the SJU Administrative Board's Rules of Procedure, a Written Procedure for the approval of the current decision was launched on 17 December 2020 and concluded on 12 February 2021 with positive results.
