

**DECISION
GB(D)03-2022**

Adoption of the Bi-Annual Work Programme 2022-23

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SESAR 3 JOINT UNDERTAKING (“SESAR 3 JU”),

Having regard to:

- The Council Regulation (EU) 2021/2085 of 19 November 2021 establishing the Joint Undertakings under Horizon Europe and repealing Regulations (EC) No 219/2007, (EU) No 557/2014, (EU) No 558/2014, (EU) No 559/2014, (EU) No 560/2014, (EU) No 561/2014 and (EU) No 642/2014¹ (“Single Basic Act”), and in particular Article 17(2)(f) and (k) and Article 25 thereof,
- The Regulation (EU)2021/695 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing Horizon Europe,
- The SESAR 3 JU Governing Board decision GB(D)02-2021 adopting SESAR 2020 JU Administrative Board decision ADB(D)23-2019 adopting the “European ATM Master Plan 2020 (Level 1 - Executive view)” that shall continue to apply for the SESAR 3 JU,
- The Commission Communication on “The European Green Deal”, COM(2019) 640 final,
- The SESAR 3 JU Financial Rules adopted by the Governing Board on 14 December 2021, GB(D)01-2021, and in particular Articles 16, 17 and 33.

Whereas:

- (1) On 25 February 2022, the draft 2022-2023 Bi-Annual Work Programme (hereafter the ‘2022-2023 BAWP’) was sent to the Members of the SESAR 3 JU Governing Board for initial review. Comments from Members of the SESAR 3 JU Governing Board were integrated in the final version to the extent possible.
- (2) On 14 January 2022, the European Commission adopted its opinion on the draft Single Programming Document for 2022-2024 of the SESAR 3 JU (C(2022) 45 final) which was transmitted to the SESAR 3 programme office on 17 January 2022. In its reply dated 25 January 2022 the SESAR 3 JU programme office committed to reflect the specific

recommendations provided by the European Commission on the draft SPD 2022-2024 in the Bi-Annual Work Programme for years 2022-2023.

- (3) On 24 February 2022, the States' Representative Group (SRG) was consulted and expressed its positive opinion, with the following recommendations: " Stress a risk on the availability of budget (including capping) for WA6 to complete critical Phase C activities pending the final outcomes of SESAR 2020 and inviting the SESAR 3 JU programme office to revert to the SRG with a risk assessment in relation to the roll-out of Phase C of the Master Plan when the outcome of the call planned to be launched in April is known. On that basis the SRG may formulate additional recommendations to address this risk."

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Bi-Annual Work Programme (BAWP) for years 2022-2023 is adopted.

Article 2

The 2022-2023 BAWP comprises the SESAR JU Budget for year 2022 and for year 2023 pending confirmation from the budgetary authority of the availability of the budget.

The 2022-2023 BAWP shall be made publicly available on the website of the SESAR 3 JU.


Article 3
