PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

Mr Hugues de Beco has 30 years' experience in the aerospace industry, in particular in Aircraft Systems.

He started in 1987 as an avionics engineer in Sextant Avionics (Thales) in flight management system design.

He then joined AIRBUS, in 1992, in Procurement for various responsibilities in Equipment Purchasing dealing with a large scope of avionics equipment contracts.

He then came back to Engineering in the Design Office and had positions of head of projects (new Flight Management System, FANS-Future Air Navigation System) and as Head of group of Data Link.

In 2001, Mr de Beco joined the A380 program having the program leadership on multiple Navigation and Cockpit systems. In 2007, still in the A380 program organisation, he took the accountability of a larger scope leading the Aircraft On Board Maintenance & Information System development. He then came back in the Design Office leading the Domain of the Maintenance & Information Systems for all Airbus Aircraft in the Systems Centre of Competence.

Since March 2018, Mr de Beco is Head of the Multi Program Projects & Air Traffic Management organization. This program organization is in charge of creating added value for AIRBUS & the Airlines, by identifying, launching, and developing innovative Multi-Program projects and Air Traffic Management projects, integrated into our aircraft and the global air transport system.
