PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

Mariluz de Mateo Garcia started her professional career in 1988 at the European Space Agency, ESA, Noordwijk (The Netherlands), where she was responsible for the technical management of various contracts with the European aerospace industry in the fields of communication and satellite navigation (GNSS). In 1995, she was appointed responsible for the technical management of the European EGNOS navigation satellite system.

Mariluz joined AENA in 1996 and was appointed Head of the EGNOS programme Office. In 2005, she was appointed Head of the GNSS Development Division, within the AENA's Directorate of Engineering and Technical Exploitation. In 2008, she was appointed Head of Strategy and Planning of the Directorate of Air Navigation of AENA, and in 2012 Head of International Development and Convergence.

Since 2008, Mariluz is responsible for managing all the international relationships, policies, business development activities and international programs of ENAIRE (formerly AENA). She is also responsible since that date to negotiate, direct and coordinate the participation of ENAIRE in the SJU programme. She is the representative of ENAIRE at the SJU PC and the alternate representative of ENAIRE at the SJU ADB.
