

- Contribute to the objectives of the Green Deal and the Sustainable and Smart Mobility Strategy
- Contribute to the development of the TEN-T, including adaptation of parts of it for the civilian-defence dual use
- At least 60% of the financial envelope will be dedicated to the Union's climate targets



Common Projects coordinated by SESAR Deployment Manager

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/116 of 1/02/2021) in accordance with the deployment approach defined in the SESAR Deployment Programme.

Focusing on: Extended AMAN and Integrated AMA/DMAN in the high-density TMA, Airport Integration and Throughput, Flexible Airspace Management and Free Route Airspace, Network Collaborative Management, System Wide Information Management, Initial Trajectory Information Sharing.

Other ATM Projects

Projects implementing Communications, Navigation and Surveillance ground and airborne infrastructure, route and procedures that are not addressed by Common Projects.

Digital Sky Demonstrators

Projects that accelerate the transition to deployment of a number of SESAR solutions in order to fully leverage breakthrough technologies that can contribute to the defragmentation of European skies.


Focusing on: U-space and urban air mobility, green aviation (green approaches, procedures aiming at reduction of C02 emissions, fuel savings, reduction of noise).

Military Mobility Projects

Air transport projects upgrading / strengthening defence and civil air transport infrastructures by supporting the needs of both by complying with dual-use requirements.

Extended Arrival Management (XMAN)

- > Extension of arrival sequencing to upper sectors and neighbouring area control centers

- System designed to increase capacity in times of high traffic and traffic peaks
